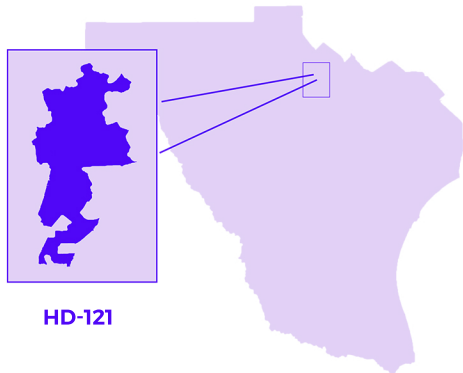


SCHOOL CHOICE: TEXAS HD-121

TEXAS VOTERS & SCHOOL CHOICE

An overwhelming (bipartisan) majority of Texas voters support state-funded school choice.

BELIEFS AND HABITS OF THE REGION

- This region has a **higher opinion of teachers' unions than they do charter schools** but are not likely to be members of a union themselves.
- In this region, **charter schools have a higher favorability rating than the government** by more than 20%.
- When asked what **word best described their feelings toward the government**, people in this region most often said **disappointment**.
